Using 6.50 mm hook worsted
weight yarn

12 sc and 13 rows - 4 inch square

Beginner Newsboy

Materials Needed

5.5 mm hook

6.5 mm hook

Buttons (optional)

Buttons are not recommended for younger children as they pose a choking hazard.

Tapestry Needle

Finished Measurements

0 to 6 months	14.5" x 6"
6 to 12 months	16" x 7"
12 months – 3 Years	17.5" x 8"
3-10 Years	19x 9"
Preteen to Adult	19.5" x 10"

Little Extras

ROSE 5.00 mm hook

Row 1: Ch 55, 1 dc in 5th chain from hook, *Ch 1, sk 1 ch, (dc, ch1, dc) in next st* rpt from *to* till end of row, ch 2 turn

Row 2: *(hdc, 4 dc, hdc) 1st ch1 sp, sl st in next ch1 sp* rpt from *to* till end of row

Roll rose into shape very loosely so that rose stays large and flat.

DECORATIVE BAND

Using 5.5 mm hook, chain until you get to desired length, dc in 3rd ch from hook, dc in each ch, ch2 at the top of last dc made. Sl st into bottom of last dc made. Sl st into bottom of each dc. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Use needle and thread to attach buttons. Slip buttons through dc on each end of band.

0 to 6 Months

*Hat is worked in continuous rounds. Do not join. Use a stitch marker at the beginning of round for easier counting

Using 6.5 mm hook ch2

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd st from hook. (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in 1st st and each st around (12)

Rnd 3: 1 sc in 1st st *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (18)

Rnd 4: 1 sc in 1st 2 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 2 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (24)

Rnd 5: 1 sc in 1st 3 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 3 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (30)

Rnd 6: 1 sc in 1st 4 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 4 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (36)

Rnd 7: 1 sc in 1st 5 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 5 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (42)

Rnds 8-15: Sc in 1st st and each st around. (42)

Change to 5.5 mm hook

Rnds 16-18: Sc in 1st st and each st around (42)

BRIM (will be worked in rows)

With right side facing, join yarn with slip stitch in 11th st from fasten off point.

Row 1: Working in front loops only, sc in 1st 3 sts, 2 sc in next, sc next 9 sts, 2sc in next, sc next 3 sts, ch 1 turn (19)

The rest of the pattern will be worked through both loops

Row 2: Sk 1st st, sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next, sc next 6 sts , 2 sc in next, sc next 4 sts, sk next st, sc in last, ch 1 turn (19)

Row 3: Sk 1st st, sc across, sk 2nd to last st, sc in last st, ch 1 turn (17)

Row 4 : Sk 1st st, sc across, sk 2nd to last st, sc in last st (15) Fasten off and weave in ends.

Join yarn at the centre back fasten off point and work either rsc or sc around entire cap, including brim.

6 to 12 Months

*Hat is worked in continuous rounds. Do not join. Use a stitch marker at the beginning of round for easier counting

Using 6.5 mm hook ch2

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd st from hook. (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in 1st st and each st around (12)

Rnd 3: 1 sc in 1st st *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (18)

Rnd 4: 1 sc in 1st 2 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 2 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (24)

Rnd 5: 1 sc in 1st 3 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 3 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (30)

Rnd 6: 1 sc in 1st 4 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 4 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (36)

Rnd 7: 1 sc in 1st 5 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 5 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (42)

Rnd 8: 1 sc in 1st 6 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 6 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (48)

Rnds 9-19: Sc in 1st st and each st around. (48)

Change to 5.5 mm hook

Rnds 20-22: Sc in 1st st and each st around (48)

BRIM (Will be worked in rows)

With right side facing, join yarn with slip stitch in 12th st from fasten off point.

Row 1: Working in front loops only, sc in 1st 3 sts, 2 sc in next, sc next 9 sts, 2sc in next, sc next 3 sts, ch 1 turn (19)

The rest of pattern will be worked through both loops

Row 2: Sk 1st st, sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next, sc next 6 sts , 2 sc in next, sc next 4 sts, sk next st, sc in last, ch 1 turn (19)

Row 3: Sk 1st st, sc across, sk 2nd to last st, sc in last st, ch 1 turn (17)

Row 4: Sc in 1st st and each st across (17)

Row 5 : Sk 1st st, sc across, sk 2nd to last st, sc in last st (15) Fasten off and weave in ends.

Join yarn at the centre back fasten off point and work either rsc or sc around entire cap, including brim.

12 Months – 3 Years

*Hat is worked in continuous rounds. Do not join. Use a stitch marker at the beginning of round for easier counting

Using 6.5 mm hook ch2

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd st from hook. (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in 1st st and each st around (12)

Rnd 3: 1 sc in 1st st *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (18)

Rnd 4: 1 sc in 1st 2 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 2 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (24)

Rnd 5: 1 sc in 1st 3 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 3 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (30)

Rnd 6: 1 sc in 1st 4 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 4 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (36)

Rnd 7: 1 sc in 1st 5 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 5 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (42)

Rnd 8: 1 sc in 1st 6 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 6 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (48)

Rnd 9: 1 sc in 1st 7 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 7 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (54)

Rnds 10-20: Sc in 1st and each st around (54)

Change to 5.5 mm hook

Rnds 21-23: Sc in 1st st and each st around (54)

BRIM will be worked in rows

With right side facing join yarn with slip stitch in 13th st from fasten off point.

Row 1: Working in front loops only, sc in 1st 4 sts, 2 hdc in next, hdc next 12 sts, 2 hdc in next, hdc next 4 sts, ch 1 turn (24)

The rest of pattern will be worked through both loops

Row 2: Sc in 1st 6 sts, 2 sc in next, sc next 10 sts, 2sc in next, sc next 6 sts, ch 1 turn (26)

Row 3: Sc in 1st st and each st across (26)

Row 4: Sk 1st st, sc across, sk 2nd to last st, sc in last st, ch 1 turn (24)

Row 5: Sk 1st st, sc across, sk 2nd to last st, sc in last st (22)

Row 6: Sk 1st st, sc across, sk 2nd to last st, sc in last st (20) Fasten off and weave in ends.

Join yarn at the centre back fasten off point and work either rsc or sc around entire cap, including brim.

3-10 Years

*Hat is worked in continuous rounds. Do not join. Use a stitch marker at the beginning of round for easier counting

Using 6.5 mm hook ch2

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd st from hook. (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in 1st st and each st around (12)

Rnd 3: 1 sc in 1st st *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (18)

Rnd 4: 1 sc in 1st 2 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 2 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (24)

Rnd 5: 1 sc in 1st 3 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 3 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (30)

Rnd 6: 1 sc in 1st 4 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 4 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (36)

Rnd 7: 1 sc in 1st 5 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 5 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (42)

Rnd 8: 1 sc in 1st 6 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 6 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (48)

Rnd 9: 1 sc in 1st 7 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 7 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (54)

Rnd 10: 1 sc in 1st 8 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 8 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (60)

Rnds 11-21: Sc in 1st st and each st around. (60)

Change to 5.5 mm hook

Rnds 22-24: Sc in 1st st and each st around (60)

BRIM will be worked in rows

With right side facing join yarn with slip stitch in 14th st from fasten off point.

Row 1: Working in front loops only, sc in 1st 4 sts, 2 sc in next, sc next 16 sts, 2 sc in next, sc next 4 sts, ch 1 turn (28)

The rest of pattern will be worked through both loops

Row 2: Sc in 1st 6 sts, 2 sc in next, sc next 14 sts, 2sc in next, sc next 6 sts, ch 1 turn (30)

Row 3: Sc in 1st st and each st across, ch 1 turn (30)

Row 4: Sk 1st st, sc across, sk 2nd to last st, sc in last st, ch 1 turn (28)

Row 5: Sc in 1st 14 sts, 2 sc in next, sc next 13 (29)

Row 6: Sk 1st st, sc across, sk 2nd to last st, sc in last st (27)

Row 7: Sk 1st st, sc across, sk 2nd to last st, sc in last st (25)

Join yarn at the centre back fasten off point and work either rsc or sc around entire cap, including brim.

Adult

*Hat is worked in continuous rounds. Do not join. Use a stitch marker at the beginning of round for easier counting

Using 6.5 mm hook ch2

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd st from hook. (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in 1st st and each st around (12)

Rnd 3: 1 sc in 1st st *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (18)

Rnd 4: 1 sc in 1st 2 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 2 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (24)

Rnd 5: 1 sc in 1st 3 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 3 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (30)

Rnd 6: 1 sc in 1st 4 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 4 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (36)

Rnd 7: 1 sc in 1st 5 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 5 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (42)

Rnd 8: 1 sc in 1st 6 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 6 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (48)

Rnd 9: 1 sc in 1st 7 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 7 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (54)

Rnd 10: 1 sc in 1st 8 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 8 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (60)

Rnd 11: 1 sc in 1st 9 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 9 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (66)

Rnds 12-25: Sc in 1st st and each st around. (66)

Change to 5.5 mm hook

Rnds 26-28: Sc in 1st st and each st around (66)

BRIM will be worked in rows

With right side facing join yarn with slip stitch in 17th st from fasten off point.

Row 1: Working in front loops only, sc in 1st 4 sts, 2 sc in next, sc next 16 sts, 2 sc in next, sc next 4 sts, ch 1 turn (28)

The rest of pattern will be worked through both loops

Row 2: Sc in 1st 6 sts, 2 sc in next, sc next 14 sts, 2sc in next, sc next 6 sts, ch 1 turn (30)

Row 3: Sc in 1st st and each st across, ch 1 turn (30)

Row 4: Sk 1st st, sc across, sk 2nd to last st, sc in last st, ch 1 turn (28)

Row 5: Sc in 1st 14 sts, 2 sc in next, sc next 13 (29)

Row 6: Sk 1st st, sc across, sk 2nd to last st, sc in last st (27)

Row 7: Sk 1st st, sc across, sk 2nd to last st, sc in last st (25)

Join yarn at the centre back fasten off point and work either rsc or sc around entire cap, including brim.

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Please remember that there may be a slight variance in sizing due to different tensions of each individual crocheter and materials used. If you are looking for an alternate yarn to use it is recommended that you try to substitute using a yarn with a yarn gauge (the gauge shown on the band on the yarn) as close the yarn recommended on the pattern.
