Skill Level

Beginner

Abbreviations

ch – chain

sc – single crochet

sk – skip

st – stitch

sts – stitches

sl st – slip stitch

rpt - repeat



Gauge

3 sts = 1.5 inches

2 rounds = .75 inches

Super Bulky Beanie

Materials Needed

9.0 mm hook

10 mm hook

Buttons (optional)

Tapestry Needle

Stitch Markers

Pompom if desired

170g / 97m Super Bulky Yarn

(I used Loops and Threads Cozy Wool - Coney Island shown in photograph - note you will need more than one skein for the XL)

Finished Measurements

0-6 Months	13.5" x 4.5
6-12 Months	15" x 5.25
1 - 3 Years	16.5" x 6"
3-10 Years	18" x 6.75"
Adult	19.5" x 7.5"
Adult XL	21" x 8.25"

0 to 6 Months

*Hat is worked in continuous rounds. Do not join. Use a stitch marker at the beginning of round for easier counting

Using 10 mm hook ch2

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd st from hook. (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in 1st st and each st around (12)

Rnd 3: 1 sc in 1st st *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (18)

Rnd 4: 1 sc in 1st 2 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 2 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (24)

Rnd 5: 1 sc in 1st 7 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 7 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (27)

Rnds 6-7: Sc in 1st st and each st around. (27)

Change to 9.00 mm hook and continue below

Rnds 8-10: Sc in 1st st and each st around. (27)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

6 to 12 Months

*Hat is worked in continuous rounds. Do not join. Use a stitch marker at the beginning of round for easier counting

Using 10 mm hook ch 2

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd st from hook. (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in 1st st and each st around (12)

Rnd 3: 1 sc in 1st st *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (18)

Rnd 4: 1 sc in 1st 2 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 2 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (24)

Rnd 5: 1 sc in 1st 3 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 3 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (30)

Rnds 6-9: Sc in 1st st and each st around. (30)

Change to 9.00 mm hook and continue below

Rnds 10-12: Sc in 1st st and each st around. (30)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

1 - 3 Years

*Hat is worked in continuous rounds. Do not join. Use a stitch marker at the beginning of round for easier counting

Using 10 mm hook ch 2

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd st from hook. (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in 1st st and each st around (12)

Rnd 3: 1 sc in 1st st *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (18)

Rnd 4: 1 sc in 1st 2 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 2 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (24)

Rnd 5: 1 sc in 1st 3 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 3 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (30)

Rnd 6: 1 sc in 1st 9 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 9 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (33)

Rnds 7-11: Sc in 1st st and each st around. (33)

Change to 9.00 mm hook and continue below

Rnds 12-14: Sc in 1st st and each st around. (33)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

3 - 10 Years

*Hat is worked in continuous rounds. Do not join. Use a stitch marker at the beginning of round for easier counting

Using 10 mm hook ch 2

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd st from hook. (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in 1st st and each st around (12)

Rnd 3: 1 sc in 1st st *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (18)

Rnd 4: 1 sc in 1st 2 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 2 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (24)

Rnd 5: 1 sc in 1st 3 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 3 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (30)

Rnd 6: 1 sc in 1st 4 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 4 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (36)

Rnds 7-13: Sc in 1st st and each st around. (36)

Change to 9.00 mm hook and continue below

Rnds 14-16: Sc in 1st st and each st around. (36)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Adult

*Hat is worked in continuous rounds. Do not join. Use a stitch marker at the beginning of round for easier counting

Using 10 mm hook ch 2

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd st from hook. (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in 1st st and each st around (12)

Rnd 3: 1 sc in 1st st *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (18)

Rnd 4: 1 sc in 1st 2 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 2 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (24)

Rnd 5: 1 sc in 1st 3 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 3 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (30)

Rnd 6: 1 sc in 1st 4 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 4 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (36)

Rnd 7: 1 sc in 1st 11 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 11 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (39)

Rnds 8-15: Sc in 1st st and each st around. (39)

Change to 9.00 mm hook and continue below

Rnds 16-18: Sc in 1st st and each st around. (39)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Adult XL

*Hat is worked in continuous rounds. Do not join. Use a stitch marker at the beginning of round for easier counting

Using 10 mm hook ch 2

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd st from hook. (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in 1st st and each st around (12)

Rnd 3: 1 sc in 1st st *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (18)

Rnd 4: 1 sc in 1st 2 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 2 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (24)

Rnd 5: 1 sc in 1st 3 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 3 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (30)

Rnd 6: 1 sc in 1st 4 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 4 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (36)

Rnd 7: 1 sc in 1st 5 sts *2 sc in next st, 1 sc in next 5 sts* rpt from * to * till end of rnd (42)

Rnds 8-16: Sc in 1st st and each st around. (42)

Change to 9.00 mm hook and continue below

Rnds 17-20: Sc in 1st st and each st around. (42)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Please remember that there may be a slight variance in sizing due to the different tensions of each individual crocheter and materials used. If you are looking for an alternate yarn to use I recommend that your substitute has a yarn gauge (the gauge shown on the band on the yarn) as close to the yarn recommended on the pattern.
